PROJECT DETAILS: The Client's Children and Families Department identified an increased need for pupils with special educational needs and profound learning disabilities. Resolving this need was the main driver for the project.

Specifically, a need for a rebound therapy centre was identified and this was required to be sympathetically placed within the school grounds without causing harm to the setting of the listed buildings or the surrounding ecology.

The phase 1 building includes therapy hall, Autism Spectrum Disorder classrooms, sensory room and garden. A second phase included an extension to the existing hall, as well as extended reception and administration areas. Internal modifications were also made to the building to improve safeguarding.
